II. General information about data processing

1. Scope of the processing of personal data

Our processing of the personal data of our users is limited to the data that is required to provide a properly functioning website as well as our content and services. We process personal data of our users only for the purposes agreed with you or if another legal basis (within the meaning of the GDPR) exists. We collect only the personal data that is actually required to perform and settle our tasks and services or that you have made available to us voluntarily.

2. Your rights (rights of the data subject)

You have the right to demand information from us about the personal data we process relating to you. In particular, you may demand information about the purposes of the processing, the categories of the personal data that is being processed, the categories of the recipients to whom your data has been or will be disclosed, the planned retention period, the existence of a right to correction, erasure, limited processing or objection, data portability, the origin of your data, insofar as this was not gathered by us, as well as the existence of an automated decision-making procedure including profiling.

You also have the right to revoke any possible consent to use your personal data at any time.

If you are of the view that the processing of your personal data by us breaches the applicable data protection provisions, you have the opportunity to complain to the Data Protection Office.

III. Description and scope of the data processing

1. Google Analytics

Our website uses "Google Analytics", a web analysis service of Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94.043 USA, to evaluate use of the website. Google Analytics uses cookies (see Fig. 2.) that are saved on your computer. The information these contain about the website and internet use of the user can be processed and evaluated by Google.

The data collected by Google may possibly be transmitted by Google to states outside the EU and EEA, in particular to the USA. Google has, however, subjected itself to the Privacy Shield Framework. The legal basis for the use of Google Analytics is Art. 6 Para. 1 p. 1 lit. f GDPR.

2. Cookies

We use cookies on our website in order to make our services more user-friendly. Cookies are small computer files that your browser automatically creates and are saved on your device (laptop, tablet, smartphone etc.) when you visit our website. The cookies remain saved until you delete them. This enables us to identify your browser the next time you visit.

If you do not want this to happen, you may use browser settings to inform you about the use of cookies, enabling you to permit this on a case-by-case basis. We wish to point out, however, that deactivation will mean that you cannot use all of the functions of our website.

The legal basis for the use of data processed by cookies is Art. 6 Para. 1 p. 1 lit. f GDPR.

The cookies remain valid for a specific period of time, and are then deleted by your browser.

3. Contact form

If you complete a contact form or send us a mail or other electronic message, your details will be used only to process the enquiry and possible associated questions, will be saved and used only within the context of the enquiry.

The legal basis for the processing of your enquiry is Art. 6 Para. 1 p. 1 lit. b GDPR.

We will delete your e-mail address once we have settled your enquiry or the mandate has ended.

4. Social plugins (LinkedIn)

All integrated social plugins function using the 2-click procedure; that is to say, the recording of your surf behaviour by a plugin starts only after you have activated the corresponding plugin with a click. If you simultaneously visit our website while logged into your LinkedIn account, LinkedIn registers the page visit once the plugin is activated (first click) and can attribute this visit to your user account.

IV. Data security

We deploy the widely used SSL process within the context of website visits in conjunction with the respective highest encryption level that is supported by your browser. You can identify whether an individual section of our website is being transmitted in encrypted format by the key or closed padlock symbol in the lower address bar of your browser. We also use appropriate technical and organisational security measures to protect your data from accidental or wilful manipulation, partial or complete loss, destruction or from being accessed by unauthorised third parties. Our security measures are improved on an ongoing basis in accordance with technological developments.
